

Greenwood Friends School Admissions Process & Timeline

- 1. **School Tour & Family Visit** A family wishing to enroll a student typically tours the school, meets with the Head of School, and receives an Admissions Application either at the school or from the website.
- 2. **Submit an Application -** The family completes the application to describe their child and submits it to the school. The school will confirm receipt of the application.
- 3. **Student Classroom Visit & Screening** The school will coordinate a classroom visit for the child and the parents will complete the Health Information for Half-Day Visit form in preparation for the child's visit. During the classroom visit, conversation, observation, and a brief screening for age-appropriate skills takes place. If a family applies in the summer, arrangements will be made for the teacher to meet and assess the student.
- 4. **Tuition Assistance** All families regardless of financial circumstances <u>must</u> complete the TADS online tuition assistance application. This process will ensure that families receive appropriate discounts and tuition reductions that we offer from time to time. Refer to the form "Tuition Assistance Process."
- 5. **Notification & Enrollment** Families will be notified as soon as possible once an Admissions decision has been made. When a student is accepted, families receive a contract listing any tuition assistance award and other discounts. To confirm enrollment, you must sign the enrollment contract and submit it with the non-refundable deposit which is credited towards tuition. Typically, families have until mid-March to accept or decline admission, although GFS continues to accept applications throughout the year providing space is available. Please note that payment of the tuition deposit ensures a place for your child at Greenwood Friends School.
- 6. **Forward Student Records** (for new students entering Grades 1-8) GFS will provide a Records Release Form to your child's current school. GFS will also alert your home school district of transportation that they can provide your child.
- 7. **School Forms & Information -** At the beginning of the school year, enrolled families will receive a packet of school forms (emergency contacts, grandparent day information, etc.) to complete and return to GFS. A school community directory will be issued to enrolled families in September.
- 8. **Welcome Events** In August, all enrolled families are invited to an End of Summer Picnic to meet and greet each other. In September, a Parents Back-to-School Night orientation is held for 'parents only' to hear from teachers and the Head of School about the plans for the year.
